Dear Applicant:

The Notre Dame Innovation Lab, McHugh's Restaurants, and Elevate CCIC, Inc. are pleased to welcome your application to participate in the 2021 Maker Internship. (ND Maker Internship) This unique opportunity will allow three individuals from (CHS, MHS, and LLC) in the Coles County area to participate in a 8 week paid summer internship at the University of Notre Dame. Students who are selected will be employed by the **University of Notre Dame for their 8 weeks and receive \$12 an hour** (or \$480 a week Gross). The internship will commence on Monday June 7th, 2021 and end Friday July 30th, 2021. All Transportation, Housing, Food and Basic Necessities will need to be addressed by the student and/or their guardian. Housing recommendations will be provided, if selected. At the end of this program, the student will gain enough aptitude to be a formally certified **SolidWorks** Associate. After the program Elevate CCIC, Inc. will be available to provide a space to work, and help formalize their Idea into a business.

The tentative schedule is as follows:

- Weeks 1-2: SolidWorks immersion, culminating in formal CSWA certification (Certified SolidWorks Associate)
- Week 3: 3D Printing immersion, culminating in formal certification (via Dasai Systems)
- Weeks 4-6: Corel Draw/Laser Cutting immersion.
- Weeks 7-8: Launch a product-based company (*either individually or as a team*). Skill development in Starting an LLC with EIN, Establishing an Operating Agreement, obtaining a Business Checking, Launching a Shopify Ecommerce platform, Product Management, Social Media Marketing... and much more.

The selection committee will be looking for candidates who are interested in 3D Printing, Laser Cutting, General Making, Product Development, and or launching a business. This cohort is supported by the business community in Coles County in partnership with **Elevate CCIC, Inc.** and **Notre Dame Idea Innovation Lab.**

As a member of this Cohort, you will be challenged in new and exciting ways, and you will learn under the supervision of Coles County Native Professor Matt Leevy. In addition, you will have the opportunity to develop a lasting and important network of contacts. You will be expected to pay for your housing, transportation to and from Notre Dame, food and basic necessities.

The Cohort meets from 9am-5pm Monday- Friday at the Idea Center Innovation Lab at the University of Notre Dame. Plan on spending time outside of the school day following through with the work and projects if needed.
